

2017 POINTS OF EMPHASIS

Each year, as needed and when appropriate, there are important changes made to the rules. When this happens, those changes are listed here for ease of reference.

Show Membership

Application for show membership in the Association shall be filed with the Association Secretary at the beginning of Show Year, accompanied by a show fee of \$150.00 per show.

Prize List Requirements

1. For any BCHSA Division that is offered at a show, it must adhere to the guidelines as set forth in the Rule Book for that division. All classes that are offered as part of the division **MUST ADHERE** to the specifications. Any class that runs as part of a BCHSA division that does not go by the rules as stated will not towards year end awards.
2. Junior on Pony, Junior on Horse, Pre-Children's/Adult and Adult Medal Classes will be included on the prize list for all BCHSA pointed shows and cannot be combined with any other Association medals.
3. In the case of a two-day show, the Junior on Pony Medal class must be offered on the day that the pony classes run in the schedule.
4. BCHSA Medals require 3 entries to fill the class.

Small/Medium Low Pony Hunter

Division must run together as one class and not combined with other associations that allow large ponies.

Classic Points

Classic Points will not be used for champion/reserve at the show, but the points are added to the Year-End points for the division.

Annual High Point Awards

To receive a Year - End award, a Horse/Pony in a Hunter or Pleasure division and a Rider in an Equitation division must have accumulated at least six (6) points.

Medals Rule Change

Once a rider has qualified for the medal finals (12 points) the rider is no longer eligible to compete in the class for the remainder of the show season. Exceptions can be made for a qualified rider to compete when needed to fill the class at the discretion of the show management. The steward will need to be notified immediately.
